Lisa Brockman made a motion seconded by Jodi Swatek to approve Kristi Plenty as treasurer, this motion carried.


A motion was made by Bonnie Kruiuzenga to accept Melissa Haney as the Southwest District Representative seconded by Tim Boss, this motion carried.

October 24, 2016

The Walworth County Junior Leaders' Association met on October 24, 2016 in the County Government Center following a joint meeting with the Senior Leaders' Association during which members of the 2016 State Conference delegation presented about their experience.

The Junior Leaders' meeting began with an ice breaker led by President Braden Kundert. The meeting was officially called to order at approximately 7:30 pm. Brandan Constable led the pledges. The secretary's report given by Lillie Cauffman and was accepted by Owen Kramer and seconded by Maya Ehlen. The treasurer's report was given by Amelia Hayden with \$9403.33 in the checking account and \$6,183.43 in the CD it was accepted by Brandan Constable and seconded by Leo Ehlen. The amendment to the budget that was noted on the agenda was briefly discussed, but was dropped.
