Walworth County 4-H Junior Leaders' Association Minutes September 26, 2016

The Walworth County Junior Leaders' Association met on September 26, 2016 in the County Government Center. The Junior Leaders' meeting was called to order by President Devon Frederick at 7:20 pm following a presentation by Gateway Technical College. Sarah Haacker led the pledges. The secretary's minutes were approved after a motion by Evelyn Harkness, which was seconded by Rebecca Wells. The treasurer's report was given by Braden Kundert; there is currently a checking balance of \$9,760.89 and a CD balance of \$6,183.43. The report was accepted by motion of Leo Ehlen and second of Rebecca Wells. Leo Ehlen motioned to accept the 2016-17 Program Year Budget as presented, and it was seconded by Mackenzie Constable. Braden Kundert led an icebreaker and Amelia Guanci presented a ribbon wreath activity which members can present and use at their club meetings.

Unfinished Business

In unfinished business, the Wisconsin State Fair Pork Shoppe, at which several members volunteered, was discussed; Mackenzie and Brandan Constable, Sarah Haacker, Amelia Hayden, Braden Kundert, Devon Frederick, and Lillie Cauffman all volunteered.
