## PRIVATE APPLICATOR?

If you or your employees purchase, mix, or apply **Restricted Use Pesticides** on property you own or operate in Wisconsin, you **MUST** be certified to do so. Certification is valid for 5 years.

## TWO CERTIFICATION OPTIONS

1. Attend a half-day private applicator training session at a local UW-Extension office and take an open-book test after the training. Those that attend a training will need a test score of at least 50% for certification.
2. Study on your own and schedule an independent, open-book test at a local UW-Extension office. Those who select the self-study option will need a test score of at least 70% for certification.

## HOW TO REGISTER FOR A TRAINING SESSION OR SELF-STUDY TEST

- Fill out the attached registration form.
- Register and purchase a General Farming training manual for **\$30.00** at a local UW-Extension office (Racine, Kenosha or Walworth) at least one week prior to the training session/desired test date.

*\*The registration form can be sent in and training manuals mailed to you, but only after a check made payable to UW-Extension is received for \$35.00 (\$30.00 fee plus postage).*
