

Walworth 4-h club Membership guidelines/ bylaws

Membership

1. Members must be in third grade through 1 year beyond high school
2. Cloverbuds- Kindergarten through second grade

Enrollment must be completed on-line by December 1st & behavioral forms and dues
turned in at the November meeting. New members must complete on-line enrollment and turn in behavior forms and dues by March 1st in order to show at the Walworth county fair.

To obtain membership in good standing:

1. *Attend at least 5 club meetings*
2. participate in at least 1 club or county fundraiser
3. *Carry at least 1 project*
4. Turn in a record book for county level by the Sept. meeting, all other record books are due at the Oct. meeting. *A record book must contain a completed activity report, be enclosed in the green 4-h cover. Completed ppr form and is to*

1. Club meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of each month at the Walworth Elementary School at 7:00 pm

3. All members under the age of 16 years should be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.
