


Wednesday, June 6, 2018! (1st Wed)

We are meeting at the **Hoard Historical Museum**
 401 Whitewater Ave, Fort Atkinson at 6pm

The Jefferson County Master Gardeners will give us an informal tour of all their gardens on the grounds, including the Peony Garden that was established in 2010 under the direction of Roger Anderson and Jefferson County Master Gardener Volunteers. It is the largest public collection of intersectional peonies in North America, and features 58 peonies developed by Roger Anderson. There are 18 named intersectional varieties, and 2 tree peonies in the garden. The front of the garden retaining wall also features unnamed varieties of daylilies developed by Roger. **There is a cost of \$5/person for this tour payable upon arrival.**
